

Connecting with Nature on Fiscalini Ranch Preserve



Fiscalini Ranch Preserve is open for people to connect with nature, release some anxiety, and see beyond their current troubles. It will continue to be open while it is safe to do so.

To improve the chances that the Ranch will remain open for recreation, Cambria Community Services District and Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve have instituted temporary one-way routes on the Bluff and Marine Terrace trails, widened the paths, reminded people to keep their dogs on leash, and asked for the courtesy of safe distancing and respectful passing.

This week we will be installing new bilingual signs on the Bluff and Marine Terrace so it will be easier for everyone to follow these rules. As summer visitation begins, simplified signs should help new visitors enjoy the Ranch safely. These signs were supported by a generous grant from The California Wellness Foundation.


