Celebrating the 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve was a highlight of 2025, and a chance to look back with appreciation and ahead with purpose. In May, we gathered many of the Ranch's founders for a dinner at Robin's, bringing together the people who turned determination into lasting protection.

Trailhead gifts, boardwalk dedications, and tree plantings all speak to the care this community has for the Preserve. A special gift from Carole Adams improved trail crossings, making them safer for visitors while protecting sensitive habitat. And the Board's 25<sup>th</sup> Challenge surpassed expectations, with supporters nearly doubling our goal!

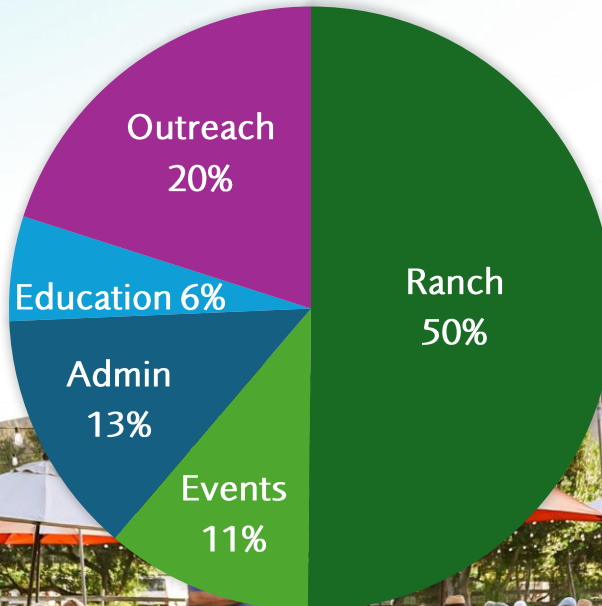

# MESSAGE FROM STEVE SANDKE, TREASURER



In 2025, Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve (FFRP) received donations totaling over \$488,000, including two substantial bequests. Other sources of income in 2024 included \$51,500 in membership dues, \$9,300 from fundraising events and \$34,800 of other revenue.

Normal operating expenses in 2024 were \$469,000. The organizations financials are reported on a cash basis, and the net income will be used for projects in the upcoming years.

FFRP maintains a minimum of one year of spending in cash and reserves to protect against negative markets and related revenue impacts. The organization ended the year with \$359,000 in cash and short-term reserves.

The markets' strong performance in 2025 resulted in investment income gain of \$773,000. The organization ended 2025 with \$6.57 million in long term investments. Market conditions are affected by economic and political situations around the world and can change quickly. However, FFRP's long term investments will support current operations with judicious financial management.

FFRP complies with all relevant federal and state laws governing nonprofit financial management. The organization is also guided by internal policies associated with spending, investing, endowment, reserve and operating cash.

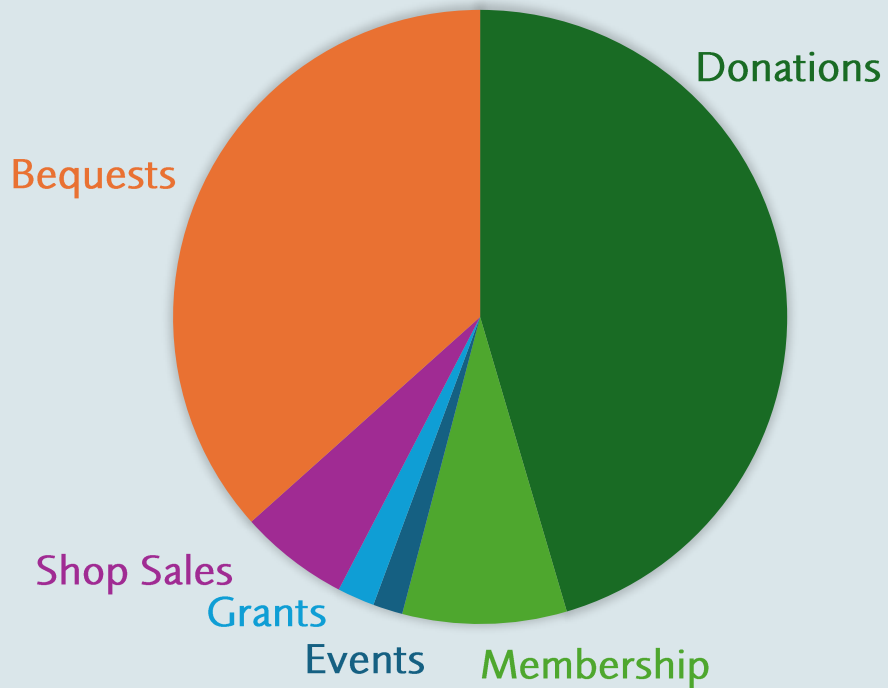

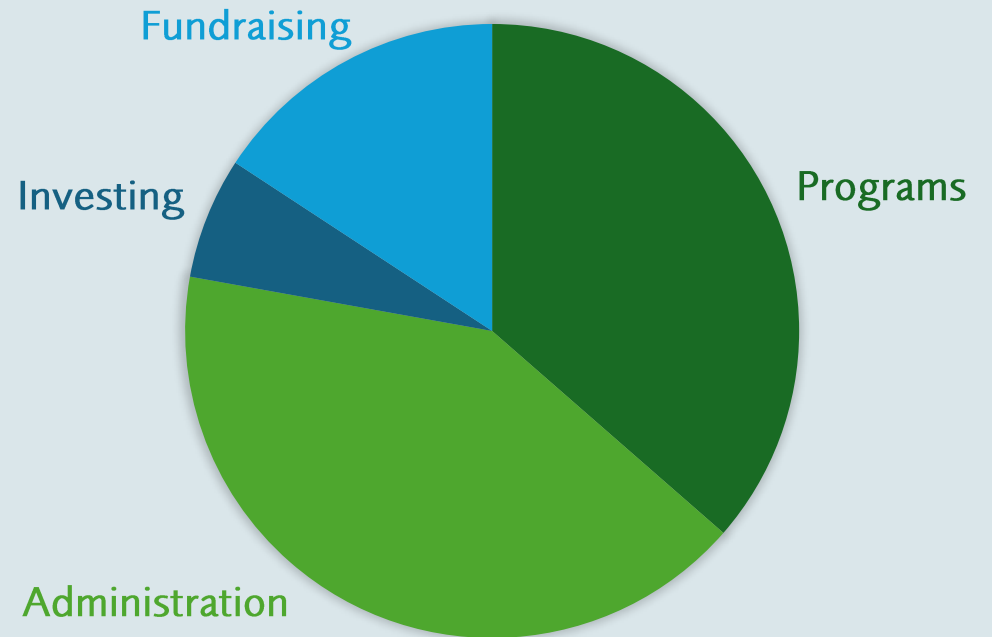
# 2025 INCOME AND EXPENSES
