Saturday, July 3, Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve (FFRP) is holding a **Pop-up Sale** on the Ranch. From 9 AM to 1 PM, FFRP volunteers will staff a booth just outside the south entrance to the Bluff Trail, near Windsor Boulevard and Wedgewood Street. Street parking is available.

We are located at 604 Main, between Sandy's Deli & Bakery and Maddie Mae's Pet Pantry. Store hours are 11 AM and 2 PM on Thursdays and Saturdays.
