
MISSION

MESSAGE FROM DIANNE ANDERSON, BOARD CHAIRPERSON

Thirty years ago, I set foot on the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve for the first time and found myself in a state of wonder at what I saw: forest, marine terraces, and bluffs with awe-inspiring vistas of scenic beauty and fascinating spots to study nature. I had no idea what the status of the land was, I just knew I was in love.

Six years ago, when my husband and I became full-time Cambrians, my passion for the Ranch was ignited again. By then a small group of committed citizens had prevailed in a decade-long effort to save the ranch from development and preserve it for public access in perpetuity. I wanted to be part of preserving this extraordinary expanse of land, for all and forever.

Now, with four years on the Board and in my fourth month as Board Chairperson, I'm increasingly aware that, while the formidable task of saving the Ranch from development is complete, the never-ending industry that helps it thrive is not. I'm more aware than ever that what we got 25 years ago was not only this amazing treasure but also the promise to protect and nurture it forever, a fact that gives me pause and causes an occasional sleepless night.



Today, saving the Ranch has been replaced by the tireless work of dozens and dozens of volunteers who care for the Ranch as though it were their own prized garden, as well as docents who share their knowledge about and passion for the Ranch with others, and the incredible generosity and support provided by our members and donors.

In that vein and on behalf of the Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve (FFRP) Board of Directors, I want to express my profound appreciation to each of our members, staff, volunteers, donors, and community partners for another year of significant accomplishments in maintaining, protecting and improving the natural beauty of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve.

MESSAGE FROM KITTY CONNOLLY, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

As I reflect upon this year, I see a tapestry of challenges and resilience. Post-pandemic, my spirits were buoyed with hope for Fiscalini Ranch Preserve's restoration and conservation efforts. Yet, nature had other plans.

Cataclysmic winter storms struck, leaving our new restoration nursery in disarray. The March flood dismantled our nursery and wreaked havoc across the East Ranch. Though we rescued our precious Monterey pine seedlings in time, they fell victim to a destructive water mold and were lost.

Faced with disaster, we reached out to partners for help. With funding from grants and tree dedications, we contracted with the Santa Barbara Botanic Garden to grow even more plants than we could have grown on our own and we purchased seedlings from Greenspace-Cambria for a small planting in January 2024. Soon we will move the nursey program to a provisional home while looking forward to rebuilding in a permanent, safe location.



The departure of our cherished Ranch Manager, Carlos Mendoza, marked the end of an era. His stewardship was a beacon of dedication, and although he will be missed, we warmly welcome David Aguirre as our new guardian of the Ranch.


These challenges led to the deferral of our crusade against the intrusive ice plant on the bluffs. Additionally, the development of the critical linking boardwalk is unfolding more slowly than anticipated. Yet, with the environmental and planning reviews complete and CCSD's approval on the horizon, we are optimistic about completing this vital project within the year.

Throughout these difficulties, it is your unwavering support that has been our stronghold. Your commitment to conservation and the principle of open access propels our mission forward.

RECREATION & ACCESS ACHIEVEMENTS

The linking boardwalk passed another milestone when construction plans were approved by San Luis Obispo County Department of Building & Planning. We will be using innovative low-impact footings to minimize soil disturbance and the potential for sedimentation.

We know that walks on the Ranch are a beloved highlight for many. But just how many? No one has ever known, so FFRP placed counters at entrances to the Bluff and Marine Terrace Trails. Within the first eleven months, we discovered that these two trails are visited at least **250,000** times each year!

RESTORATION ACHIEVEMENTS

In March 2023, the normally placid Santa Rosa Creek rose from its average depth of under 3' to peak at 21', sweeping through the East Ranch and swamping the restoration nursery. We remain undeterred and are going to rebuild the program and the nursery.

While major ice plant removal was on hold in 2023, we just could not resist making some progress. With the help of our regular weeders and volunteers from the Sierra Club and Leffingwell High School, work continued along the north Bluff Trail.

FOCUS ON OUTREACH

Jo Ellen Butler, retired executive director of Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve (FFRP), led a triumphant return of the Cambria Wildflower Show in 2023. More than 600 people came to view the dazzling diversity of plants found in northern San Luis Obispo County.

Around 16 adventurous collectors brought hundreds of specimens to Cambria's Veterans Memorial Hall on the Friday before the weekend show so the plants could be identified and prepared for display by another group of dedicated volunteers. D.R. "Doc" Miller led the botanical identification team with the assistance of Al Normandin and Mark Markwort. Marcelle Bakula organized her volunteers to prepare the specimens and displays.

Walt Andrus took the lead in preparing the hall for the show, including setting out some tables loaned by the Lions Club. Suzy Siegler and Becky Kincaid shepherded the Wildflower Café that featured treats from local bakers, delicious lunches, and welcome coffee. Barbara Beuche recruited volunteers to staff the FFRP pop-up booth where business was hopping. The California Native Plant Society sold helpful references for native plant identification and gardening.

How many plants were on display? No definitive answer was available, but a rough count put it around 500. With the heavy winter rain and late spring warming, the plants were in peak condition, fully hydrated and ready for their spot in the show. FFRP looks forward to doing it all again in April 2024.

MESSAGE FROM MARY MAHER, TREASURER



Friends of the Fiscalini Ranch Preserve (FFRP) received a significant bequest in 2023 which increased the total donations to \$212,000. Other sources of income in 2023 included \$43,000 in membership dues, \$11,000 from fundraising events and \$20,000 of other revenue.

Operating expenses in 2023 were \$252,000 which resulted in a net income of \$34K driven by the large number of donations. The organization's financials are reported on a cash basis and the net income will be used for projects in the upcoming years.

FFRP maintains one year of spending in cash and reserves to protect against negative markets and related revenue impacts. In addition, the majority of the funds required to build the planned linking boardwalk project, including a large bequest in 2022, also reside in our reserve account. The organization ended the year with \$743,000 in cash and short-term reserves.

The market's positive performance in 2023 resulted in investment income gain of \$750,000. The organization ended 2023 with \$4.7 million in long term investments. Market conditions are affected by economic and political situations around the world and can change quickly. However, FFRP's long term investments will support current operations with judicial financial management.

FFRP complies with all relevant federal and state laws governing nonprofit financial management. The organization is also guided by internal policies associated with spending, investing, endowment, reserve and operating cash.


